It has been a year of expansion and growth at Bethany Christian Services – Minnesota. Especially, here in Central and Southwest Minnesota. The Lord has continued to open doors in ways that only He could do. We continue to have conversations with local social work agencies expressing their desire to partner with Bethany Christian Services. In January the Minnesota Department of Human Services reported they expect a staggering 17,000 children in the state of Minnesota to be placed into the Foster Care System.

Our Counseling Services continue to expand in exciting ways. We have hosted Trust Based Relationship Intervention (TBRI) Training for Sunday School Teachers & Volunteers, as well as been asked to host TBRI training next year for an agency in Southern Minnesota.

Currently, I am meeting with fifteen families and individuals, focusing primarily on adoption and foster care-related issues. It has been fun to see families heal and grow when they begin to understand and implement trauma-informed principles and parenting strategies.

There is a need for services like Hope and Choices, as well as for Expectant Parent Advocacy that Bethany has.

- 3 kids in pre-adoptive homes
- 1 family finalized the adoption of a 7-yearold in August and is considering starting the adoption process again.
- 5 Foster Care-Adoption Families waiting to Adopt.

We are looking for more foster families. We continue to get inundated with calls from the county asking us if we have anymore families. We NEED more families available to meet the NEED.
