## **Living Word Lutheran Church Re-Gathering Plan** **Effective May 27, 2020 ~ Updated July 25, 2020**

As you know, Governor Walz has issued new guidelines for churches that he and his team called “Re-Opening.” We are calling it “Re-Gathering”. That is an important clarification for us because churches were never closed! The church is the people of God, not the building. We never stopped preaching and worshipping together. The Holy Spirit is moving. Buildings can be shut, but a church is never closed. God’s people know this. It is one of the great gifts that God gives – a church is any gathering of people who seek the Lord. Do we wish we could be together, face to face, hugging, shaking hands, encouraging one another in faith? Absolutely, and we will be again as soon as we can to fully enhance the ministry together.

**2. “In indoor settings, occupancy must not exceed 50% of total occupancy, with a maximum of 250 people in a single self-contained space.”** *This order still requires physical distancing between people who do not live in the same household. Thus, the max number of 250 doesn’t apply to us because we can’t get 250 in our sanctuary while following the required guidelines of social distancing. We estimate our maximum number to be approximately 200.*

**3. “In outdoor settings, gatherings must not exceed 250 people.”** *This is our best option for getting the most people gathered for worship in a setting that has the least possibility for infecting those around us.*

**4. The church facility will be available to visitors, groups, and studies with some limitations and guideline, while following the MN and CDC guidance for Faith Communities. The facility will be open during regular office hours.**

*If you are at a higher risk for COVID-19, you are strongly urged to stay home. If you are not feeling well, please stay home and contact your primary care provider as necessary. These measures are in place for your own safety, as well as the safety of others. It will be your own personal risk and responsibility by choosing to attend.*

- *Please call ahead to arrange a meeting with the Pastors and/or staff or to use the facility.*
- *Stop at the Information Center when you arrive on-site. This will be the check-in point to help follow physical distancing.*
- *The Adult Ed Room will be the only room available for all groups and studies, unless approved otherwise by staff. Participants must do a self-check prior to attending, provide their own food & drink, maintain physical distancing at all times. The Leader will communicate with the participants each week with a quick reminder of the safety measures and answer any questions you may have. Leaders will be expected to sanitize the used space after the meeting/event.*
- *As of July 25, 2020, people in Minnesota are required to wear a face covering in all public indoor spaces and businesses, unless alone or exempt from the face covering requirement, per Executive Order 20-81. This includes the church, sanctuary and offices. Workers and visitors are required to wear a face covering when working outdoors when physical distancing cannot be maintained. Face coverings can be temporarily removed in*

*situations such as eating, drinking or communing, providing physical distancing can be maintained. The server should wear a face covering in these instances. Visitors should provide their own face covering or ask the office for one. Face coverings are NOT a substitute for maintaining a physical distance of 6-feet from other people.*

**5. Our pastors, staff and leadership have decided that we will worship outside until we can fulfill the needed sanitation guidelines outlined in the government documents. Where and how we do worship could also change if guidelines shift and we are either further restricted, or they loosen up the requirements.**

*Starting Sunday June 7<sup>th</sup> we invite you to join us for outdoor worship at Living Word at 10:30AM. We will have one service at 10:30AM unless the number worshipping exceeds 250. If/when that happens, we will have two outdoor worship services at our normal worship times of 8:00 and 10:30. We will also continue to have live stream worship available on our YouTube channel for those who prefer, or who need to continue worshipping from home for health or safety reasons.*

- *The church parking lot entrance from Highway 23 will be blocked off on Sunday mornings. Please use the entrance on Southview Court East to access the church parking lot.*
- *We ask that you practice physical distancing between members of other households at all times while on the church property. This includes the people next to you, in front of you and behind you. We will have ushers helping direct you.*
- *Bring your own chair.*
- *Bring your own coffee and snacks. There will not be food or drink available on-site.*
- *There will be an offering box for you to drop your offering into on Sunday mornings. We still highly encourage you to consider using online and mobile giving options or sign up for automated Simply Giving.*
- *The church building is not open on Sunday morning unless you need to use the bathroom. No more than two people at a time should be in the bathrooms at any one time unless you are from the same household. We'd suggest not using the bathrooms at all unless you have to! All other areas of the church are off limits.*
- *The lyrics for the Worship Service songs will be attached to the Thursday email and posted on the homepage of the website. Please either print your own copy to bring along or use your mobile device to pull them up. Printed copies will not be distributed on Sunday mornings. Furthermore, we will continue to email the Announcement Folder on Thursday's in lieu of distributing paper copies on Sunday mornings. Please email Kim if you'd like to be added to the email list.*
- **Cleaning** - *We will need a team of 5 people willing to stay after services and wipe down doors and bathroom surfaces. Please email Kim if you are willing to serve in this way!*

**6. There's no better time than now to practice sacrificial love for your neighbor.**

- *"Participants should conduct a self-check and stay home if they or a member of their household have symptoms of COVID-19." Please see the guideline links above for detail on self-checks.*
- *For the safety of others, feel free to take your temperature before coming to church. If you feel fine but are running a "low-grade temp" please stay home.*
- *Participants are advised to stay home if they have had a "significant exposure to COVID-19".*
- *"Persons who may be at higher risk for severe illness are strongly encouraged to stay home." All of us want to be together in worship, but some of us should not return to public worship. Those in a high-risk group should stay home. We have the great gift of online live stream Worship Services. As we have mentioned many times, we feel your presence with us when worshipping together on-line. The Holy Spirit is uniting us in powerful ways. Staying home and worshipping with us online is a faithful way to gather! Be Safe. Be Wise.*
- *As of July 25, 2020, people in Minnesota are required to wear a face covering in all public indoor spaces and businesses, unless alone or exempt from the face covering requirement, per Executive Order 20-81. Visitors should provide their own face covering or ask the office for one.*
- *Respect others by keeping a safe distance from them. We want people to feel safe. We want people to be focused on Jesus when they come to worship. Let's make every effort to help others return to the fellowship that we all so badly long for.*
